Take crome<sup>1</sup> of almañd. dry it in a cloth. and whan it is dried do it in a vessel, do þto salt, sug<sup>9</sup>, and white powdō of gyng<sup>9</sup> and Juys of Fenel and wyne. and lat it wel stonde. lay full & messe & dresse it forth.

Take peer<sup>9</sup> and pare hē clene. take gode rede wyne & mulberes<sup>n</sup> oþ sañdr and seeþ þ peer þin & whan þei
