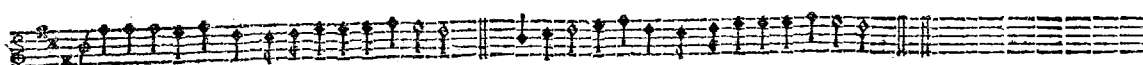


Once I loved a Maiden faire *Long for as many as will*      ♪ ♪ ♪ ♪ ♪ ♪



Lead up all a D. and back ♪ That again ♪ Set and turn S. ♪ That again ♪

First man and 2. Wo. meet a D. and back ♪ then the first Wo. and 2. man as much ♪ The first man change with the 2. Wo. he into her place and she in to his ♪ The first Wo. and 2. man as much ♪ Doe thus to all the rest following.

The first man take the 2. man in his right hand, and the first Wo. the 2. Wo. in her left hand and meet a D. and backe ♪ That againe ♪ Then meet and goe through between each other, the uppermost man about his Wo. and the 2. man between the first Wo. and his owne, and turne your faces each to your owne being in the Co. places ♪ Then take hands and goe halfe round, and fall the first Cu. in the 2. place ♪ Doe thus to all, the rest following.

The first man take his Wo. in his left hand and the 2. man take his Wo. in his right hand and fall backe a D. and meet againe ♪ That againe ♪ First man cast off his Wo. casting off at the same time into the 2. place, the 2. Cu. following them till they come to their own places ♪ Cast off againe and stay the first Cu. in the 2. Cu. place ♪ Doe thus to all the rest following.
