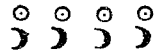


My Lady Cullen

Leade up all a D. and backe — That againe ∴ Set and turne S. — That againe ∴

First Cu. crosse over and fall on the outside into the 2. place and change places — The first foure hands all a brest and lead up to the pefence and fall back ∴

Right hands a crosse and goe round all foure — Left hands a crosse and goe round back againe —

First Cu. cast off and falling into the 2. place, slip between the 2. Cu. the first man standing before the 2. man, and the first Wo. before the 2. Wo. — The 2. Cu. cast off and falling between the first, stand as before ∴

The 2. Cu. take both hands and slip up whilst the first Cu. take both hands and slip downe, holding hands so still, both Cu. slip together — Set and turne S. ∴

First Cu. crosse over and fall on the out side into the 2. place — The first foure hands a brest and lead up to the pefence, and back againe ∴

Each face to his owne and clap your hands, We. Armes, whilst the men Armes — Armes each other with his owne, the first Cu. in the 2. place, and the 2. Cu. in the first place ∴
