

Gees in hoggepot<sup>m</sup>. xxxi.

Take Gees and smyte hem on pecys. cast hem in a Pot do þ<sup>o</sup> half wyne and half wa<sup>r</sup>. and do þ<sup>o</sup> a gode q̄ntite of Oynoñs and erbest. Take the brawn of Swyne. pboile it and grynde it smale and alay it up with zolkes of ayren. set it o<sup>u</sup>e<sup>p</sup> the fyre with white Grece and lat it not seeþ to fast. do þ<sup>o</sup> pinne Safrōñ ā powd<sup>o</sup> fort and messe it forth. and cast þ<sup>o</sup> pinne powd<sup>o</sup> douce. and s<sup>u</sup>e it forth.

Chykeñs<sup>q</sup> in Cawdel. xxxiii.

Take Chykeñs and boile hem in gode broth and ramme<sup>r</sup> hem up. þenne take zolk of ayren ā þe broth and alye it togedre. do þ<sup>o</sup> powd<sup>o</sup> of gyng and fug<sup>u</sup> ynowh safrōñ and salt. and set it o<sup>u</sup>e the fyre withoute boyllyng. and s<sup>u</sup>e the Chykeñs hole<sup>s</sup> o<sup>p</sup> ybroke and lay þ<sup>o</sup> fowe onward.
