

Pygg⁹ in sawfe Sawge^h. xxix.

Take Pigg⁹ yfkaldid and quar^r hē and seeþ hem in wa^r and falt, take hem and lat hēm keleⁱ. take þfel sawge. and grynde it with brede and zolkes of ayreⁿ harde yfode. temp^r it up with vyneg⁹ sū what thyk. and lay the Pygg⁹ in a vessell. and the fewe onoward and sūe it forth.

Take sawge. þfel. yfope. and saūay. qñces. and peer^h, garlek and Grapes. and fylle the gees þerwith. and sowe the hole þat no grece come out. and roost hem wel. and kepe the grece þ^r fallith þof. take galyntyne and grece and do in a possynet, whan the gees both rosted ynouh. take ā smyte hem on pecys. and þat tat¹ is withinne and do it in a possynet and put þinne wyne if it be to thyk. do þto powdō of galyngale. powdō douce and falt and boyle the sawfe and dresse þ^r Gees ī dishes ā lay þ^r sowe onoward.
