

## PRAYERS.

Repentance in mee, and by thy Spirit, pover and grace, so to humble, mortifie, and feare my conscience for my finnes to saluation, that in thy good time thou maist comfort and quicken mee againe, through Iesus Christ thy dearely beloved Sonne. So be it.

### *A Prayer before the receiuing of the holy Communion.*

O Father of mercy and God of all consolation, seeing all creatures doe acknowledge and confesse thee to be their Governour and Lord it becommeth vs, the workmanship of thine owne hands, at all times to reuerence & magnifie thy godly maiestie: first, for that thou hast created vs to thine owne Image, & similitude but chiefly because thou hast deliuered vs from that euerlasting death and damnation, into which fathian drew mankind by the means of sin, from the bondage whereof, neither man nor Angell was able to make vs free: but thou (O Lord) rich in mercy and infinite in goodness, hast provided our redemption to stand in thine only and wellbeloued Son, whom of very loue thou didst giue to be made man like vnto vs in all things, sin excepted, that in his body hee might receiue the punishment of our transgression, by his death to make satisfaction to thy iustice, and by his resurrection to destroy him that was the author of death, and so to bring againe life to the world, from which the whole offspring of Adam was most iustly exiled. O Lord wee acknowledge that no creature was able to comprehend the length, breadth, depth, and height of that thy most excellent loue which moued thee to shew mercy where none was deserued, to promise and giue life where death had gotten victory, to receiue vs into thy grace when we could doe nothing but rebell against thy maiestie.

The blinde dulnesse of our corrupt nature will not suffer vs sufficiently to weigh these thy most ample benefits. Yet neuertheless at the commandment of Iesus Christ our Lord, we present our selues to this table, which he hath left to be used in remembrance of his

death vntill his coming againe, to declare and witnesse before the world that by him alone wee haue receiued libertie and life: that by him alone thou dost acknowledge vs to be thy children and heyres; that by him alone wee haue entrance to the throne of thy grace, that by him alone we are possessed into our spirituall kingdome to eat and drinke at his table, and with whom we haue our conuersation presently in heauen, and by whom our bodies shall be raised vp againe from the dust, and shall be placed with him in that endless ioy which thou (O Father of mercy) hast prepared for thine elect before the foundation of the world was laid. And these most inestimable benefits we acknowledge & confesse to haue receiued of thy free mercy & grace, by thine only beloved Son Iesus Christ. For the which therefore we thy congregation, moued by thy holy spirit, do render to thee all thanks, praise and glory for euer and euer.

### *A thanksgiving after the receiuing of the holy Communion.*

MORE mercifull Father, wee render vnto thee all praise, thanks, honour, and glory, for that it hath pleased thee of thy great mercie to graunt vnto vs miserable sinners, so excellent a gift and treasure, as to receiue vs into the fellowship and company of thy deere Son Iesus Christ our Lord, whom thou hast deliuered to death for vs, & hast giuen him vnto vs a necessary food and nourishment vnto euerlasting life. And now wee beseech thee also (O heavenly father) to graunt vs this request, that thou neuer suffer vs to become so vnkinde as to forget to vvorship thy benefits, but rather imprint & fasten them sure in our hearts; that wee may grow and increase daily more and more in true faith, which continually is exercised in all manner of good vorkes; and so much the rather (O Lord) confirme vs in these perillous daies & rage of sathan, that wee may constantly stand and continue in the confession of the same, to the advancement of thy glory, which art God ouer all things, and blessed for euer. Amen.
