This is taken from 3 part setting of Languir en Mille Distress tenor called "Stublin" in the Buxheim Organ book. The original is 61 (62?) breves in length.

I have broken it into three parts STT and have simplified the cantus line. Original cantus is above.

 Actually 4 mesures. Toulouse (#8) calls this danse  
*Langueur en nul soit destresse.*
