IX. For to make Lamprey fresch in Galentyne 1.

Schal be latyn blod atte Navel and fchald yt and rost yt and ley yt al hole up on a Plater and zyf hym forth wyth Galentyn that be mad of Galyngale gyngener and canel and dresse yt forth.

X. For to make falt Lamprey in Galentyne m.
