In several of the Northern Counties of England, where they have good Barley, Coak-dryed Malt, and the Drink brewed at Home, there are seldom any bad Ales or Beers, because they have the Knowledge in Brewing so well, that there are hardly any common Brewers amongst them: In the West indeed there are some sew, but in the South and East Parts there are many; and now sollows the Account, that I have Stated according to my own general Practice, viz.
