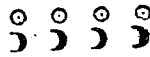

hand.

Lead up as before  $\therefore$

Sides all  $\therefore$  Turne your We.  $\therefore$  Then the 2. man stand alone the  
first taking the third man, the last Wo. take the next. Change  
thus every time till you come to your owne places.
