To approve them therefore to the Muses, and to warrant them, for the true Forme of Charactering the Time, both in impersect and persect Measures: As also to prevent the Ignorant, that they venture not, (without better Reason of the Art, then I shall give them) pracindiciously to draw the common Practise for an Argument against me, I will now, in as few words as well I may, pramise some particular Notions and Rules in the Measurable part of Musick, to which alone (and not to the other, the Playne and Simple Part:) the Resolutions of these doubts may in this case be thought necessary.
