

The Definitions and Divisions of Moode Time, & Prolation in Measurable Musick.

Ensurabilis Musice is defined to be a Harmony of divers fortes of Sounds, exprest by certaine Characters or Figures called Notes, describd on Lines & Spaces, different in Name, Effence, Forme, Quantity, and Quality, which are fung by a Mea-

sure of Time; or as(1) lo: Dunstable, (2) the man whome loan. (1) to: Dunstable Nucius in his Poeticall Musicke (and divers others) affirme to bie Mensurabe the first that invented Composition) saith, it hath his be- cap I. ginning at an Vnite, and increaseth vpward by two and by (1) lo: Nucital three infinitely, and from the highest decreaseth in like musica Peatimanner downe againe to an Vnite.

Measure in this Sesence is a Quantity of the length and shorenes of Time, either by Naturall founds pronounced by Voice, or by Artificiall, upon Instruments.

Of this Musick, Franchinus de Colonià was the first Inventor; and to guide our knowledge the better, observing the same course that Guido Arctinus did, (who instituted the forme of Plaine, or Simple Musick) He made Seales or Tables, in the which all things pertaining to the division of Perfect and imperfect Measures are contained, and by the which we may by degree attaine to the perfection of this Knowledge.

The Scales or Tables (by him instituted) of divers are vulgarly termed Mosdes, by some of better understanding, Measures; and confist of Notes, Pauses, Degrees, Signes, Perfection, and Imperfection.
