Armonicall Brethren, I have bere vudertaken with no small labour, and charge, to bring the Tunes of the Plalmes, Hymnes Euangelicall, and Songs Spirituall, (as they are

vsually sung throughout Great Brittaine) into one entire volume; which are so Composed, for the most part, that the vnskilfull may with little practice, be enabled to fing

them in parts, after a plaulible manner.

In my opinion, tis too Laborious a taske for any Man to study the attainement of the Hebrew Musicall Accents; For the Tunes vied in Dauids Time are too farre remoned from our understanding. For albeit the Hebrew Musicall Characters are placed sometimes aboue the Letter, somtimes beneath, yet the knowledge of what was signified by these Notes and Characters, was onely continued by Tradition, and is now veterly lost, though many at sundry times (as appeareth by their wrytings) baue gone about to resine it: But baning no bester subiect to worke upon, then their owne weake coniectures, they have but a little prenailed.
