



## CANTVS.

a drinke of deadly vvine.


4 But yet to such as feare thy name

O Lord grant this to me.


6 The Lord did speake from his oygne

my Lass doth Iuda guid.





thy folke, their land and coasts ?


Our vvars in hand thou vwouldst not take
