When there is a Point at the end of the *fliding* Mark, towards the Mark representing the Foot, it shews, that the *Slide* must be made on the Toc.

Slide on the Toe.



When there is a Point at the other end of the *fliding* Mark, it shews, that the *Slide* is to be made on the Heel.

Slide on the Heel.



And when there is a Point at each end of the fliding Mark, it denotes, that the Slide must be made with a flat Foot.

Slide with a flat Foot.



Of marking the Positions.

A LL the Marks which have been hitherto demonstrated, may be plac'd as well upon the half Positions or Positions, as upon the Steps, the sliding Marks only excepted.
