Take Hares and hewe hem to gobett⁹ and seeþ hē w þe blode unwaifshed in broth. and whan þey both y nouh^r cast hem in colde waī. pyke and waifshe hē clene. cole^u the broth and drawe it thurgh a stynō^j. take oþ⁹ blode and cast in boylyng waī seeþ it and drawe it thurgh a stynō^j. take Almānd⁹ unblānched. waifshe hem and grynde hem and temp it up with the self broth. cast al in a pot. tak oynoñs and pboile hē smyte hem small and cast hem in to þis Pot. cast þinne Powdō^j fort. vyneg^j ā falt.

Hares in Papdele ^x. xxiiii.

Take Hares pboile hem in gode broth. cole the broth and waifshe the fleifsh. cast azeyn^y to gydre. take obleys^z oþ⁹ wafrōus^a in stede of lozeyns^b. and cowche^c in dyfshes. take powdō^j douce and lay on falt the brōth and lay onoward^d ā messe forth.
